

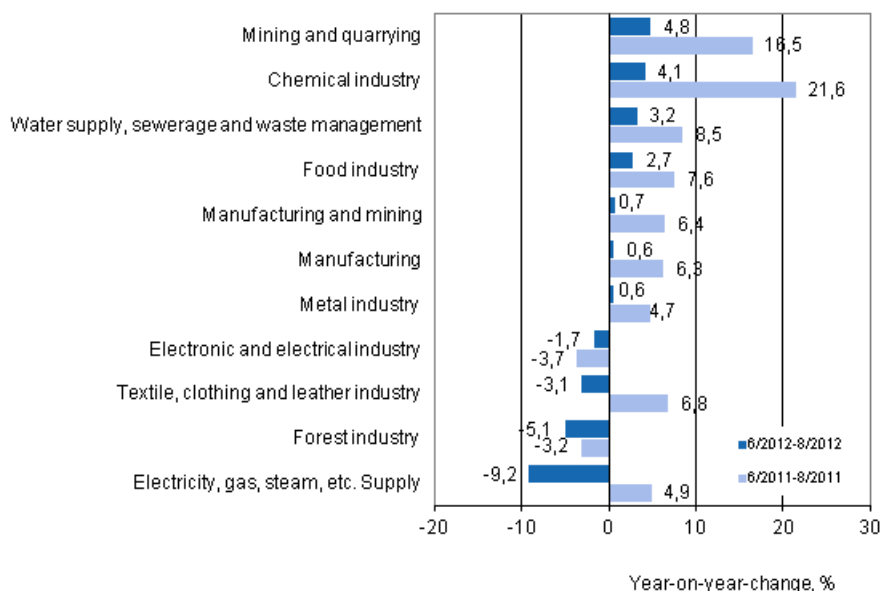
Index of turnover in industry

2012, August

Turnover in manufacturing grew by 0.6 per cent in June to August from the year before

According to Statistics Finland, turnover in manufacturing in the June to August period was 0.6 per cent higher than in the corresponding period of the year before. Domestic sales contracted by 0.9 per cent and export turnover grew by 1.9 per cent from one year ago.

Turnover went up from the corresponding period of the previous year in several sub-industries. The growth was strongest in mining and quarrying (4.8%), in the chemical industry (4.1%) and in water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (3.2%). Turnover contracted most in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (-9.2%) and in the forest industry (-5.1%). Turnover also went

down in the textile, clothing and leather industry (-3.1%) and in the electronic and electrical industry (-1.7%).

The index of turnover in industry describes enterprises whose main industry is manufacturing. The calculation of the indices is based on the Tax Administration's value added tax data which are supplemented with data obtained with Statistics Finland's sales inquiry. The monthly turnovers of manufacturing enterprises can vary considerably, especially in the metal industries. The variation is mainly due to invoicing practices. The final invoice for major machinery deliveries and projects may be recorded in the sales of one month, even if the delivery had required the work of several months or years.

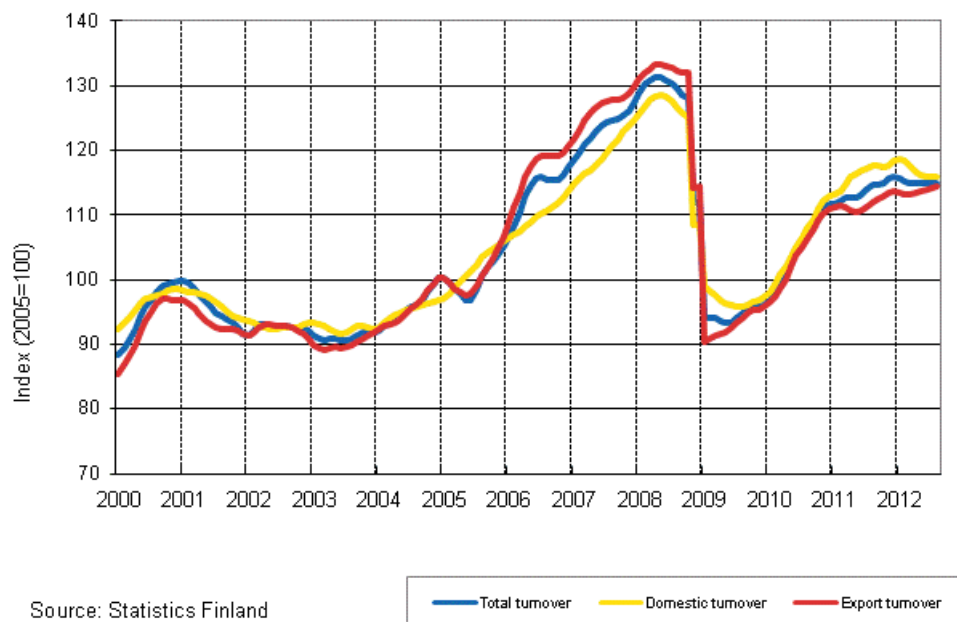

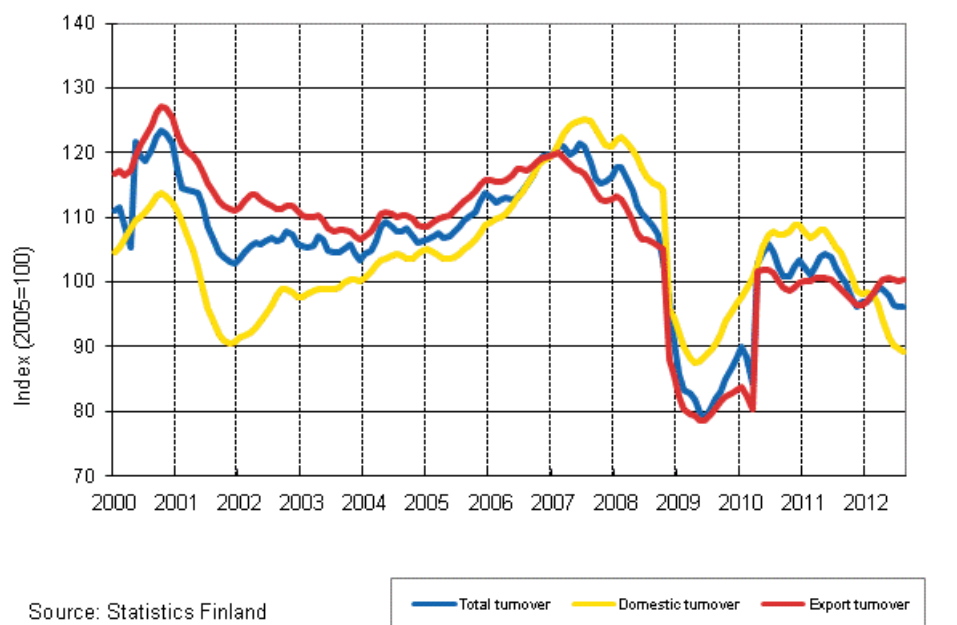

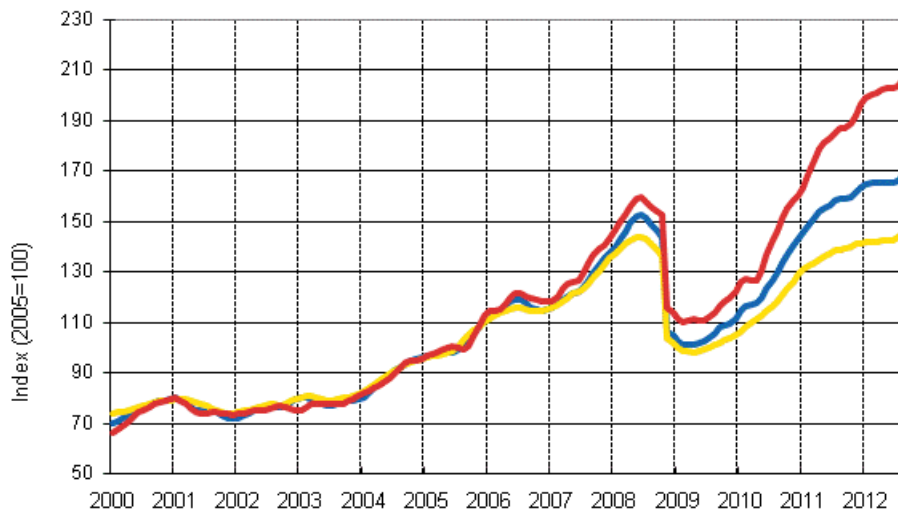
Appendix figure 1. Trend series on total turnover, domestic turnover and export turnover in manufacturing 1/2000–8/2012



Appendix figure 2. Trend series on total turnover, domestic turnover and export turnover in the forest industry 1/2000–8/2012



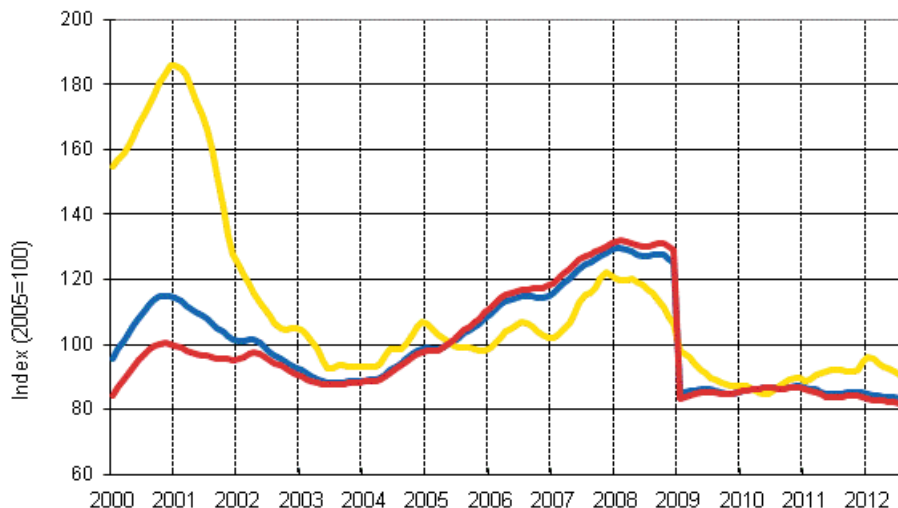
Appendix figure 3. Trend series on total turnover, domestic turnover and export turnover in the chemical industry 1/2000–8/2012
